She would watch the other dogs and kids playing through the fence and never wanted to come in.

One of her not-so-favorite things was riding in the car! She loved to sleep with her mommy in her bed and under the covers.

The Nieten Family shared some of their favorite memories: “She was truly the lap dog we searched for, for a long time. She loved sitting in mommy’s lap or next to her in the chair. When her older brother, Alex, was still home, she loved going into his bed with him when mommy went to work. More recently, her older brother, Adam, took exceptional care of her during her sick times. She loved laying on his chest and sleeping.”

Her mommy's favorite memory was when they would go to bed, she would lay on her mommy's chest and lay her head down on her cheek; then wanted to "go under" the covers and go to sleep.

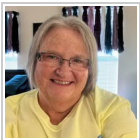

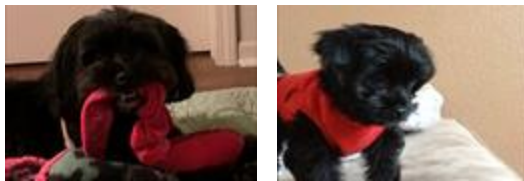

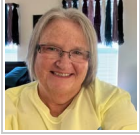
