He was talkative and funny, and made everyone around him smile. He always seemed to know how to comfort someone when they were feeling down and would often force his way onto your lap if he could sense you were feeling stressed or uneasy. When his parents would travel, all of their friends would ask if Buddy was coming along, too, always excited to see him. He brought joy to everyone around him. Buddy loved other dogs and got along with everyone he ever met. His favorite things were squirrel-watching, long walks, and snuggles with his parents and pals.

Buddy was loved beyond measure. There will not come a day in his family's lives that he won't be missed and celebrated. He will be fondly remembered as everyone's "Buddy": a true friend until the end.

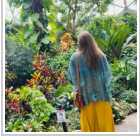
