it with her back feet.

She enjoyed lying in the hot sun upstairs. Even when she lost her sight, she still knew the rooms where the windows were that had hot sunshine in them.

She enjoyed everything.

My favorite memory is her meowing at me when she saw me. Even when she lost her senses, she knew it was me. I would walk in a room, and she knew I was there.

Her name was Hope because she gave me Hope after my previous cat, Arie passed away.
