would only bark a couple of times a YEAR. She had a couple of favorite toys but wasn't that big on playing, although she would once in a while. She really liked it when we could go on short walks. She was so small a fifteen minute walk would be plenty for her.

She liked camping with us and all the attention from all our fellow campers. We went on SO many golf cart rides, which she really liked. She would get in a sling pouch dog carrier under my arm and go campsite to campsite with me while we visited.

Lucy was truly my once in a lifetime dog. I will get another dog at some point, but she is irreplaceable. She was much loved and is terribly missed.
