You may no longer be beside us, but you'll live forever in our hearts.

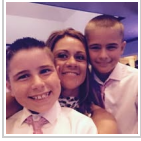
Goodbye sweet Lucy.

We'll miss you every day baby girl.

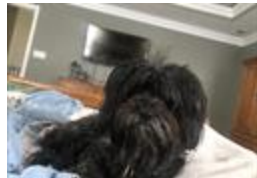
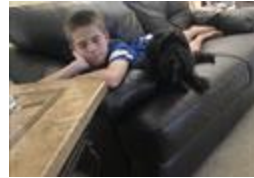

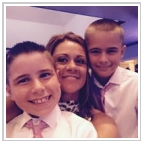
